A Word From the Grand Knight

ue to the economic downturn and reduced income, the Council has set up the following guidelines for donations and Council activities:

- There will be no more free hall rental donations for individuals or organizations.
- 2. There will be a \$500 annual limit on all donations to each organization. This does not apply to our churches ACSA relief, our annual Catholic schools donations, our member's scholarship program or the Ladies Auxiliary who will receive one annual large hall rental donation of \$975. It will also not apply to the annual MH drive and Vocations raffle where we should donate what we collect. This year's commitment to our Parishes will be honored.
- 3. Any event we have with a catered dinner will have a co-pay of ½ the catering cost to the next highest dollar. If we have a meal that costs \$9 per person the member will co-pay \$5 per person. Tickets will be sold in advance by the financial secretary, treasurer, trustees or in the lounge. A \$3 per person co-pay will be charged for the Communion breakfasts. If you attend the breakfast, you are expected to attend the mass beforehand with the group.
- 4. All Council activities, golfing, shooting, bowling, fishing trips, KC softball team activities/trips or any other activity, the participating members will be responsible for ½ the cost.

We will review these guidelines in the future after we get our finances in line and the 2010/2011 budgets is in place.

I would like to profile another one of our Legacy Active Members this month. Pictured below is Springfield Diocese Hall of Fame member John Straubinger. John is 86 years young, has been a Knight for 65 years and a 4th Degree Knight for 62 years, longer than anyone in our Assembly. He is a Past Grand Knight, Past Faithful

As a long time member of the State's 4th degree team he has recently retired after participating in the roll of Recorder for 59 degrees.
