FROM THE OFFICE OF SUPREME ADVOCATE

"Supreme Council wishes to thank the auxiliaries for their continued support of Knights and the auxiliary charitable fund raisers. However the charter, constitution and laws of the Knights of Columbus are silent on the subject of auxiliaries. In summary, auxiliaries have no formal legal connection with the Supreme Council of the Knights of Columbus or with any of its subordinate councils or assemblies. Accordingly auxiliaries may not use the Knights of Columbus or K of C in their name and may not make any use of Knights of Columbus emblems without written permission of the Board of Directors. In no case shall the Councils' auxiliary use the Councils' tax ID # and cannot hold a separate bank account under the KC name."

That is a brief summary of the letter that was discussed at the last meeting. Grand Knight Larry Ruder answered the many questions of the ladies. Thank you, Larry for your assistance.

Ladies, please attend the June meeting. We will vote on whether we should break away from the Knights totally. We have to break away from the use of name etc. and start another organization. It can still be the Ladies Auxiliary. However, the name needs to change, new bank account, professional audits of the books, get tax ID number, pay taxes on our money, and change the by-laws to accept this organization. We need to ask if we are going to continue to be attached to Illinois State Auxiliaries Ladies and follow their protocol or do we want to be just a social club with fundraisers and continue to contribute to charities.
